

OSU Extension Lorain summary of Needs Assessment Findings

Completed responses: 66 were completed from the 106 surveys distributed, response rate 62.3% approximately 20.3% higher than the statewide response rate

Completed responses statewide: 3831 (9132 surveys distributed, response rate = 41.95%)
