Fair Directors will be awarded. Applicants must have actively participated in the Lorain County Junior Fair as a 4-H, FFA, FCCLA, or Farm Bureau Youth (FBY) member. Applicant must graduate from high school in the year they apply. The scholarship may be used toward a four year degree program, a two year vocational or associate degree program or a one year trade school program. See Additional Requirements "B"
	Lorain County Junior Fair Board Scholarship - Five \$300 scholarships to be awarded by the Junior Fair Board. Applicants must be present members of the Junior Fair Board who will be entering the Fall Quarter/Semester of the coming year as either a freshman or sophomore. Applicants must have at least a 2.0 grade point average. See Additional Requirements "J" - One of the requirement three reference letters must be from a Junior Fair Board Advisor.
	Kevin N. Younglas Memorial Scholarship - One \$250 scholarship. Applicant must be currently enrolled in college, and be currently enrolled in Lorain County 4-H, or an alumni of Lorain County 4-H. Application for scholarship will be made during the spring term of the applicants' freshman, sophomore, or junior year in college. Applicants are eligible to apply again their junior or senior year of college. Scholarship may be used at any Ohio college where the applicant is enrolled in a degree in agriculture for at least a two year program.
	Beriswill Insurance Agency, Inc. Scholarship - One \$500.00 scholarship. Applicants must be a graduating senior that is a current Lorain County 4-H or FFA member, planning to enroll in any two or four year college or trade school in the fall. Applicant should be planning to pursue a degree of a business nature. See Additional Requirements "A"
	Lorain County 4-H Endowment Scholarship - Number and value of scholarship(s) to be determined by the 4-H Endowment Board each year. Applicant must be Lorain County 4-H member, 4-H Advisor, 4-H Volunteer, or 4-H Alumni. Applicant must have a 2.5 grade point average. Prior to payment, the recipient must graduate from high school and be enrolled in a two or four year college or university or a vocational or technical school. Applicants may be a high school senior or already enrolled in college but cannot be an immediate past recipient of scholarship.
	Lorain County Dairy Youth and Junior Fair Dairy Auction Scholarship - Two or more \$500 scholarships. Applicant must be a current or former Lorain County Junior Fair Dairy (bovine) Program participant. Applicants may be either a graduating senior who is currently participating in the Lorain County Junior Fair Dairy program (Division 23: Junior Fair Dairy Program) and is planning to pursue a two or four year college degree or a student who is already enrolled in college. Must be used towards four year degree, two year degree or a one year trade school program. See Additional Requirements "C"

	Carl J. Diedrick Memorial LifeShare Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship. Applicants must be current 4-H members or 4-H alumni. Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors in college may apply. Scholarship may be used for any post secondary education program which results in a degree or certification. Recipients may apply again in subsequent years. See Additional Requirements "A"
	Fox Family Perpetual Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship. Applicant must meet eligibility requirements specified for Lorain County 4-H Endowment Scholarship (see above). Also, applicant must be enrolled or about to be enrolled in post-secondary education for one of the following areas: 1) Veterinary Medicine including Pre-Vet, Vet, Technician, Research; or 2) Human Medicine including Doctor, Nurse, Paramedic, Technician, etc.; or 3) Agriculture or Ag-Business; or 4) Biology/Chemistry See Additional Requirements "D"
	Louise McConnell Memorial Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship. Applicants must be current 4-H'ers or 4-H alumni who are high school seniors or are college undergraduate students pursuing a two or four year degree at an accredited college, university or trade school. See Additional Requirements "E"
	Wellington Eagles 4-H Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship. Applicants must be graduating seniors from Wellington, Black River or Keystone High School, who are 4-H members. Preferences will be given to students whose parent or grandparent is a member of Wellington F.O.E. Students pursuing any field of study or career may apply. Recipient must enroll at an accredited institution in the continental U.S.A.
	Eva M. Weber 4-H Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship. Applicants must be a current member or alumnus of Lorain County 4-H and a freshman, sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student in college at the time of application. Applicants must be working towards either a two year associate's degree, a bachelor's degree, or an advanced degree in any field of study. Past recipients are eligible to apply again. See Additional Requirements "F"
	The Hampson Family Foundation Scholarship — One \$500 scholarship. Applicants must be a current Lorain County 4-H or FFA member or alumni and current high school senior or college freshman, sophomore or junior enrolled in an Engineering Technology Program. The scholarship may be used toward a four year degree program, a two year vocational or associate degree program or a one year trade school program. Applicants must submit evidence of acceptance or enrollment in an Engineering Technology Program.
	Glen Starbuck, Ed Studd Memorial Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship. Applicants must be graduating seniors from Amherst, Firelands or Vermilion Schools, who are 4-H, FFA or FCCLA members. Preference given to family members of the Amherst Eagles. Must be used towards a two or four year degree program, or a one-year trade school program.
	James A & Roena McConnell Family Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship. Preference will be given to a current or former 4-H, FFA or FCCLA member who will be attending an accredited 4 year, 2-year, or trade school in the fall. High school seniors may apply or consideration will be given to students already enrolled in higher education.
	Mike & Marie Yarosh Scholarship - Two \$250 scholarship. Must be a current 4-H or FFA member or alumni and be a high school senior, freshman, sophomore or junior in college. Must attend or plan on attending any college, university or trade school in the State of Ohio. Preference will be given to applicants majoring in Agriculture, Dairy Industry or Nursing Field.

	John W. Hostetler Scholarship - Two \$500.00 scholarships. Applicants must be current or former 4-H'ers or FFA members who will be attending or are currently attending a two or four year accredited college, university or trade school and pursuing a career in the agricultural field. One scholarship will be given to a graduating high school senior and the second scholarship given to a college undergraduate. See Additional Requirements "A"
	Wellington Implement Co., Inc. Scholarship – One \$250 or more scholarship. Applicants must be current or former 4-H'ers or FFA members who will be attending or are currently attending a two or four year accredited college, university or trade school and pursuing a career in the agricultural field. See Additional Requirements "G"
	Fred H. and Dorothy A. Smith Family 4-H Scholarship – One \$500 scholarship. Applicants must be graduating seniors from a Lorain County school, a current 4-H member or a 4-H alumni with five years of membership in a Lorain County 4-H club and must submit evidence of acceptance or enrollment in an accredited two or four year college as a full-time student. See Additional Requirements "D"
	Phyllis Runals Memorial 4-H Scholarship – One \$500 scholarship. Applicants must be graduating seniors from a Lorain County school, a current 4-H member or a 4-H alumni with five years of membership in a Lorain County 4-H club and must submit evidence of acceptance or enrollment in an accredited two or four year college as a full-time student. See Additional Requirements "D"
	Westover Family Scholarship – One \$250 scholarship. Applicants must be a current member or alumnus of Lorain County 4-H and a freshman, sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student in college at the time of application. Applicants must be working towards either a two year associate's degree, a bachelor's degree or an advanced degree in any field of study. Past recipients are eligible to apply again. See Additional Requirements "F"
	Lorain County Junior Fair Royal Court Contest (with Scholarship Award) - The King and Queen will each receive a \$1,000 scholarship. Applicant must be at least 16 years of age as of January 1 of the current year and not have reached their 19 th birthday prior to January 1 of the current year. Applicant must also be a current participant in the Lorain County Jr. Fair and must have been a participant for at least two consecutive years. A Court of 8 will be selected and the King and Queen will be announced during the Lorain County Fair Opening Ceremonies (Sunday first day of fair). Note: Scholarship will be awarded at the end of the year's reign. **See Additional Requirements "H"
	Betty Crawford Memorial Scholarship – Two \$250 scholarships. Applicants must be a current or former Lorain County 4-H dog project participant. Applicant may be a graduating high school senior who is currently participating in the Junior Fair Dog Project program and is planning to pursue a two or four year college degree or a student who is already enrolled in college as an undergraduate pursuing a two or four year college degree, who participated in the Lorain County 4-H dog project program. Past recipients are eligible to apply again. See Additional Requirements "I"
