- Page 7: All Three Goals (use examples on page 6 or create your own, you can add more pages to show your work)
- Pages 8-9: Topic of Interest
- Page 11: Complete Five Learning Activities (use examples on page 10 or create your own) (please show your work/add more detail using another page)
- Pages 12-13: Learning Experiences (at least 2) and Leadership Activities (at least 2) (completed and dated)
- Page 14: Summary and Project Review (please complete)
- Page 15: Care and Welfare (**MUST** have signatures and dates)
- Pages 16-19: Care You Give Your Cavy (all questions and include picture or drawing)
- Pages 21-27: Animal Records (pictures, all records, and include feed label)
- Pages 28-31: Breeding Records \*optional <u>(If you are showing sow and litter at fair, breeding records must be completed, along with copies of pages 22-27 for each animal)</u>
- Page 32: Show Participation (optional)
- Page 33: Pedigree Record (fill in what you can)
- Pages 34-40: Expense Records (must be filled out and please include receipts if possible)
- Page 38: for 4H or show record, please put your county fair show date.
