Show Schedule

Sr. Fair Board approved a tentative schedule Monday night based on our usual show schedule. Animal check-in and check-out will vary by species. Please refer to this tentative schedule on the next page.

Exhibits

Unfortunately, we are not able to exhibit any Ag, FCS, or Still Exhibit projects this year. All 4-H and FFA exhibits will be judged through virtual means. The 4-H Educator and FFA Advisor's will submit all project grades to Jr. Fair and project premiums will still be provided.

Safety Protocol

Sr. and Jr. Fair Boards are working closely with the Lorain County Health Department to ensure the safety of all Jr. Fair. Safety protocol will include physical distancing, facial coverings, and additional sanitizing schedules. Each building utilized during Jr. Fair Week will have a safety plan.

Camping

All previous camping reservations are cancelled and will be refunded. Limited camping will be offered for Jr. Fair Board, Sr. Fair Board, Jr. Fair Advisors, Jr. Fair Consultants, and family of Jr. Fair Exhibitors with animals required to stay overnight at the fairgrounds. Camping will be on a first come, first serve basis. Daily rates will apply due upon entrance to the camp area. Further details including cost is still to be determined.

Food Vendors

Sr. Fair board is planning for several food vendors to be available throughout Jr. Fair Week.

Wristband and Gate Passes

All Jr. Fair Exhibitors will receive a wristband for entrance during Jr. Fair week. Each exhibitor family will receive six daily passes to assist youth with show preparations and watch their exhibitors while in the ring.

Flowerpot Contest- Still On!!

Flowers are a great way to add beauty and joy to any landscape! Planted flowerpots must be returned to the fairgrounds the week prior to fair and be available for judging **by 7:00 p.m. on Friday, August 21, 2020**. 2020 Jr. Fair Livestock Auction

Both sales will take place at the regular times as published in the fair book.

Auctions are open to the public. The location change will accommodate social distancing and masks are required when that is not possible. Please respect this rule as it is mandated by the state.

LIVE AUCTION

1. Sales will be live, Thursday & Saturday, as originally scheduled. There will be an online component for add-on bids only.
2. When market animals come in, the exhibitor will select take-home, turn(buyback), or sale.
 - a. Take Home – animal leaves with exhibitor or private buyer after showing. Exhibitor will still be posted online for potential bidders to contribute an “add-on” bid.
 - b. Turn (Buyback) – animal is loaded on to turn truck at time set with turn truck hauler. Exhibitor will NOT go through live sale but will be posted online for potential bidders to contribute an “add-on” bid.
 - c. Sale – champion animals will walk through the sale ring, all others, will be the exhibitor ONLY. If the buyer does not have a scheduled processor date, that animal goes on the turn truck (buyback) the night of sale.
 - d. Overs & Unders must be turn (buyback) or take home. Exhibitor still eligible for add-on.

ONLINE AUCTION (Add On)

The Livestock Sale Committee will provide an auction website that will allow those buyers that choose not to attend in person an option to still donate to the exhibitor(s) of their choice. These funds will be added to the results of the Live Auction and will NOT result in possession of the animal. This is strictly a donation to the exhibitor. The website will be shared on our Facebook page when final details are determined.

Exhibitors are encouraged to still send out buyers’ letters sharing these details, if the choose to do so.

Please direct questions to our email account that can be found on our Facebook page or through messenger. We will try to answer all questions to the best of our ability with the information that we have available to us.

Finally, this format was presented by Junior Fair Board to Senior Fair Board. It was voted on and approved. We will do our best to make this year as successful as possible. Please be patient as we work through this process.
