

Dog Project and Record Book Project Book Judging Guidelines

The Dog Project and Record book, which is meant to be used with the Dog Resource Handbook, is designed for all 4-H dog projects. For each year of the project, you should complete a new project and record book. If you have more than one dog, copy the animal records section before you begin. You should have a complete set of animal records for each dog.

Each year, complete these project components:

- Complete the front cover of your book.
- Write in your project helper (page 4)
- Write in your projects required date of ownership (page 5) (April 1st)
- Identify your project goals (page 7)
- Complete the Member Project Guide section of this book, including the following:
 - One or more topics of interest (page 8)
 - Five or more new learning activities (page 10)
 - Two or more learning experiences (page 11-12)
 - Two or more leadership and citizenship activities (page 12-13)
- Complete the Dog Care and Welfare section (page 14-19) (22-23)
- Complete the Animal Records section (pages 24-36)

Be sure your project helper initials these pages

- Page 7, 10, 11, 12, 13

(Optional) Keep receipts for any project items you purchase, such as feed, grooming equipment, collars, leashes, toys, and supplies, in an envelope attached to the records section of this book.

Be sure to complete each section to the best of your ability, but also have fun learning all about your dog. Good luck!!!
