Expectations for All Court Members:

- Provide an 8 x 10 Photo for the Royal Court Fair Booth
- Must be present at Opening Ceremonies
- All Royal Court members will represent the Court during judgings, handing out awards and being visible during Livestock Sale (Thursday afternoon and Saturday).
- Attend other Fairs and Festivals throughout the year
 - Prepare to exchange pins with other Royalty

King and Queen additional expectations:

- Be an Ambassador of the Lorain County Fair, offer your public speaking services throughout the county (schools, community organizations, other Fairs and Festivals). Invite people to attend the Lorain County Fair and participate.
- Be a communicator among the court members to make sure all are aware of invitations and requests to participate in other events or attend other Fairs.
- MC the Random Question presentation for Royal Court Candidates during Scholarship Recognition Night.
- Visit at a minimum 3 other County Fairs and/or Festivals representing the Lorain County Fair.
 - Photos of visit should be taken and sent to the Lorain County Fair Secretary to be shared on the Fair's website. Email photos to: cnikel@loraincountyfair.com
 - Prepare to exchange pins with other Royalty
- Organize the Ice Cream Social the following year for visiting Royalty from other Counties,
 Festivals and the newly Crowned King and Queen.
- Return the next year to MC Opening Ceremonies and Crown the new King and Queen.

Queen Requirement

- Participate in the Ohio Fair Manager's Queens Contest in Columbus in January
 - Additional application to be completed and turned in to the Sr. Fair Board Office by October 15.
 - Dates of stay for contest should be provided as well, for Sr. Fair Board to make Hotel Reservations.
- If Queen is unable to participate in the Ohio Fair Manager's Queens Contest, the 1st Runner Up will assume the title and participate in the Queens Contest.
