

## 135 Goat Projects

### Project Book & Record Judging Guidelines

1. Only one book is required regardless if you take 1 goat or 4 goats.
2. Extra pages are always welcomed
3. Feed receipts are NOT REQUIRED
4. Look at your book as an educational tool, and do as many pages as you possibly can.

#### Page by page directions

##### **First section of the record book.**

- Page 4 thru 15 every exhibitor should complete

##### **Second section is the quality assurance.**

- Page 16 thru 34  
Even if your goat project does not require you to take quality assurance training, all exhibitors should know and understand the quality assurance section.  
If you own a goat you need to know how to care for, treat, and maintenance your animal.  
All exhibitors should fill out the quality assurance section.  
This section covers medication, feeding labels, housing.
- Page 19, 25, 29 is optional for beginners
- Page 20 (the answers are on page 21)
- Page 21 nothing is required answer key page
- Page 22, 23, 24 For dairy goats only
- Page 25 optional for beginners
- Page 26, 27, 28, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34 all exhibitors
- Page 29 optional for beginners

##### **Third section is the Animal records for all exhibitors**

- Pages 35-57
- Page 35 gives you a guideline for what pages are required for each exhibitors level.
- Page 36, 37, 38 are for all exhibitors
- Pages 39, 40, 41 for Breeding projects only
- Pages 42, 43, 44 Dairy Projects only but some of these pages are optional for beginners and Intermediate levels. So read the top of each page.
- Page 44 for advanced Dairy projects only
- Page 45, 46, 47, 48, 49 optional for beginners all others should complete these pages.  
Even if you have a Pygmy goat you should have weights on them. It may only be a beginning and end weight for each year

- Page 50 some project may not have any treatment to record. Just write none. All breeding goats and pet goats should have annual boosters at the very least.
- Page 51-57 financial reports
- Page 51 Advanced exhibitors only
- Page 52, 53,54, 55,All exhibitors
- Record expenses in your book, receipts are NOT required.
- Page 56 use this page to make extra notes or just general information. Could be information like contact information of who you buy hay from. Or contacts for resources.
- Page 57 optional for beginners. Market animals have not sold yet so project profit or loss. Or write not sold yet.

Remember this book represents you and your involvement with your project so take it seriously and do your best.
