

2024 Small Equine Versatility Rules

Rules:

- The small equine MUST compete in all classes with the same equine. The order of the disciplines are as follows: Halter - Showmanship - Trail In Hand - Hunter.
- All small equine must be three years or older to compete.
- Age is determined by how old the equine are at the beginning of the current year (not the date of foaling).
- Follow directions from the Judge.
- There will be a 2 minute tack change between classes. Each entry may have 1 helper for tack changes.
- The Hunter requirements for judging, faults elimination and jumping are to meet the requirements as specified for In Hand Hunter class in the Ohio State 4-H Rule Book, with the exception that there will only be two to four jumps.
- Trail In Hand requirements are the same as specified in the Ohio State 4-H Rule Book with the exception that there will only be 2-3 obstacles.
- Ties will be determined by the highest score in Showmanship then Trail then Hunter.
- A non-refundable entry fee of \$15.00 must accompany this entry form.
- Deadline for entry form is August 1, 2024. Late entries will not be considered.
